Year 1 Curriculum Newsletter - Spring Term

Literacy

Year 1 will be looking at fantasy stories based on Space and imaginary creatures. Year 1 will also be looking at stories from other cultures. They will then study different types of poems based on the change of Seasons.

Geography/History

Year 1 will be studying human and physical features of Rochdale. They will start by looking at their own town, county and country. Year 1 will then be focusing on the topic, 'Where we live'. This will look at Rochdale as a case study and they will be able to identify key features.

ICT

Year 1 need to be able to recognise common uses of information technology beyond school. They also need to know about using technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; and being safe when online.

Year 1 will also learn how to use 2Simple to create their own art work linked to the change in seasons.

Numeracy

Year 1 will start by looking at fractions. They should be able to name a half and a quarter of a quantity, shape or object. Year One will study time and should be able to then compare, describe and solve practical problems. They should be able to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. Year 1 will also look at one-step problems involving multiplication and division.

Science

Year 1 will be recognising the materials that objects are made from. Year 1 will describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and compare them. They will also study the change in seasons.

Art/DT

Year 1 will be studying the changes in season and complete a range of artwork to support this. Work will also be completed based on Space using chalk and other methods.

In DT, Year 1 will be using their skills on materials and will make their own design that they think will keep ears warm.
