Year 3

Literacy

Reading: Weekly comprehension lesson

Writing: Sentence structure. Language to describe (adjectives, similes, adverbs). Looking at stories with familiar settings, and by well known authors, poetry and information texts.

Compositions to include; stories, informal letter writing, character descriptions and making sensible and exciting predictions.



Numeracy

Number: Place value up to 4 digits, adding and subtracting 1,10 and 100 to 2 and 3 digit numbers. Adding and subtracting using formal methods. Learning 3,4 x tables. Investigating word problems and reasoning.

Shape: recognise & name 2d/3d shapes and their properties. Angles - identify right angles in shapes and right angle turns. Units of length, measuring.

Geography/History

Geography: Using maps and atlases, recognising mountains and looking at features and properties.

History: Looking at Prehistoric Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Animals: Habitats, food chains and predators and prey
