

Communication and Language

- * Enjoy listening to stories and remember much of what happens.
- * Use a wider range of vocabulary.
- * Sing a large repertoire of songs.
- * Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books and be able to tell a long story.
- * Be able to express a point of view and debate, using words as well as actions.
- * Start a conversation and continue it for many turns.
- * Understand how to listen and why it is important.

Physical Development

- * Develop their movements, balancing, riding and ball skills.
- * Be able to remember sequences and patterns of movement which are related to music and rhythm.
- * Collaborate with others to manage large items safely.
- * Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils.
- * Be increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed.
- * Develop the skills they need to manage the school day.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- * Develop a sense of responsibility and a membership of a community.
- * Play with one or more children, extending and elaborating play ideas.
- * Find solutions to conflicts and rivalries.
- * Increasingly follow rules and routines without an adult reminder.
- * Talk about their feelings using words like happy, sad, angry and worried.
- * Understand how others might be feeling.

Literacy

- * Develop their phonological awareness, so they can: Spot and suggest rhymes, count or clap syllables in a word, recognise words with the same initial letter.
- * Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing.
- * Write their name.
- * Write some letters accurately.
- * Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
- * Read some early tricky words.



Maths

- * Count objects, actions and sounds.
- * Subitise
- * Link the number symbol with its cardinal value.
- * Compare numbers.
- * Understand the value of numbers and apply their number knowledge to other areas of learning.
- * Begin to talk about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Understanding the World

- * Talk about what they see, using a wide range of vocabulary.
- * Show interest in different occupations. Explore and talk about different forces that they feel.
- * Continue to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.
- * Talk about members of their immediate family and community.
- * Explore the natural world around them.
- * Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

Expressive Arts and Design

- * Explore different materials freely, to develop their ideas about how to use them and what to make.
- * Join different materials and explore different textures.
- * Draw with increasing complexity and detail.
- * Show different emotions in their drawings and paintings.
- * Play instruments with increasing control to express their feelings and ideas.
- * Explore and engage in music and dance, performing solo and in groups.C
